

Internship at the Wuppertal Institute – Information

Objective

Experience of temporary course-related practice experience in the field of application oriented sustainability research.

Tasks

Usually, interns participate under supervision in third party funded projects. They mainly assist in the field of scientific investigation and data collection.

Conditions

- Interns are only provided to students registered at universities or university-level institutions. (Pupils from schools below university-level are not accepted!)
- Interns do not receive a remuneration.
- Minimum duration of an internship: 4 weeks.
In the frame of realising seminar papers, master's or doctoral theses the duration can be extended.

- The handling time of an application takes about two months.
- Required language skills: German and usually English.

Residence and work permit

- For interns from non EU-member states a residence and work permit valid is required.
