



How to get there

Wuppertal is a city of 400,000 inhabitants some 30 km east of Düsseldorf. The Wuppertal Institute is located in short walking distance from Wuppertal central station ("Hbf").

After leaving the station, just turn right and you will find the Institute opposite the InterCityHotel.



From **Düsseldorf airport** to Wuppertal

If you arrive at Düsseldorf airport, you may take a taxi to Wuppertal, but this costs about 50 EUR. You may prefer to take the next train from the airport to Düsseldorf Hbf or Haupt-bahnhof (central station) instead.

There, you would have to change trains and take the "S8" train heading for Hagen or other trains stopping at Wuppertal Hbf. The ride from Düsseldorf Hbf to Wuppertal Hbf takes about 30 minutes.

From **Frankfurt airport** to Wuppertal

If you arrive at Frankfurt airport, you are advised to take an Intercity Express (ICE) to Köln (Cologne) which leaves the airport station (two levels below "Arrivals") about every 30 minutes. In Köln you may have to change trains (usually the train towards Wuppertal

departures from the opposite side of the platform where you arrive). But you may be lucky and the Intercity Express (ICE) will take you directly to Wuppertal. The ride from Frankfurt to Wuppertal takes one hour and 38 minutes.
